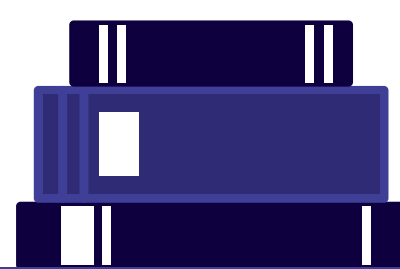

INTELLECTUAL OUTPUTS

Our Progress so far



IO1 - Transnational Information Literacy Ecosystem Mapping (TILEM):
The partners completed the six Delphi Studies, gathering all relevant results. For the time being, we are working on the last task, which is the TILEM book. Upon completion, our purpose is to upload the TILEM book in the EDUCABILITY website and in the EDUCABILITY ILTP-VLE as a scientific open access resource in an attempt to contribute to the knowledge in this field.

IO2 - Six Information Literacy Learning Modules (SILLM):
The partners created the six curricula of their courses based on the results of the mapping of the relevant literature and on the results of the six Delphi Studies that were conducted earlier in the lifecycle of the project as well as based on complementary scientific and popular resources. In particular, the partners have designed a large number of interactive comprehension and self-assessment activities in order for the interested individuals to deepen and test their knowledge and skills in Information Literacy and in the six information related literacies.

IO3 - Virtual Learning Environment & Web Portal for the Information Literacy Training Package (ILTP):
The partners reached a conclusion that the best Virtual Learning Environment to use for the purpose of our project is a Moodle platform, where the complete curriculum will be located and will be available to the wider audience. Two teams prepared a Moodle Guide in order to enable easier and more efficient work in Moodle. For the time being, we are working on transferring and transforming the content of the curriculum in Moodle, which will be evaluated by approximately 60 experts, during autumn 2022

IO4 - Transnational Memorandum of Cooperation, Sustainability and Transferability (TMCST):
All the partners agreed that they will make use of reusable materials like videos, audios, images, etc., for the creation of their modules' activities. Also, the partners will produce materials that will be reusable themselves with the appropriate Creative Commons Licenses.

3RD TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING

On April 4th & 5th, the partners met at the University of West Attica in Athens, Greece, to review and discuss the quality and progress of the project. During these two days, we focused on the development of the seven Information Literacy courses, the development of the digital toolbox, the dissemination activities, and an action plan for the following few months. It was a hybrid meeting as some partners attended face-to-face and some partners joined us online.



LEARNING, TEACHING, TRAINING ACTIVITY (LTTA)

On June 15th-17th, the partners met at the University Carlos III de Madrid, in Getafe, Spain, to undertake the Learning, Teaching, Training Activity. The purpose of the LTTA was to work together in order to eventually embed their literacies' curricula in the Information Literacy Training Package (ILTP), namely an openly accessible Virtual Learning Environment. In particular, the partners explored and actually worked on how to turn the "static" text of their courses into interactive content in the Moodle platform of the project.

During the LTTA, the partners also had the opportunity to visit and analyze the educational spaces of the university's two libraries: Library María Moliner & Library Carmen Martin Gaité.
