



Our Progress so far



101 - Transnational Information Literacy Ecosystem Mapping (TILEM):
The partners completed the six Delphi Studies, gathering all relevant results.
For the time being, we are working on the last stack, which is the TILEM book.
Upon completion, our purpose is to upload the TILEM book in the EDUCABLITY
website and in the EDUCABLITY ILTPAUE as a scientific open access resource in an
attempt to contribute to the involved one in this contribute to the involved one in this contribute.

02 - Six Information Literacy Learning Modules (SILLM)

The portners created the six curricula of their courses based on the results of the mapping of the relevant literature and on the results of the six Deph Studies that were conducted earlier in the lifecycle of the project os well as based on complementary scientific and popular resources. In particular, the portners have designed a large number of interactive comprehension and self-assessment activities in order for the interested individuals to despen and test their knowledge and skills in Information Literacy and in the six Information related literacy.

IO3 - Virtual Learning Environment & Web Portal for the Information Literacy Training Package (ILTP):

The portners reached a conclusion that the best Virtual Learning Environment to use for the purpose of our project is a Moodle plotform, where the complete curriculum will be located and will be available to the wider audience. Two teams prepared a Moodle Guide in order to enable easier and more efficient work in Moodle. For the time being, we are working on transfering and transforming the content of the curriculum in Moodle, which will be evaluated by approximately 60 experts, during outurn 2022.

IO4 - Transnational Memorandum of Cooperation, Sustainability and Transferability

All the partners agreed that they will make use of reusable materials like videos, audios, images, etc., for the creation of their modules' activities. Also, the partners will produce materials that will be reusable themselves with the appropriate Creative Commons Licenses.

Building the capacity of educators & librarians in Information Literacy

About the project

The Educability Erasmus+ project is oriented towards educators in all types and levels of education as well as librarians in all kinds of libraries, with an interest in their continuous professional development in literacy skills. In addition to Information Literacy skills, other existing and emerging literacies are considered of vital importance for personal, social and environmental feasibility. These literacies included the following six, as identified by Educability: Critical Information Literacy, Digital Literacy, Mobile Literacy, Media Literacy, Data Literacy and Sustainability Literacy.

Formal education has not yet adopted these literacies to a sufficient degree, due to organizational issues and the emerging nature of the majority of these literacies. However, educators and librarians are well-placed for the dissemination of the aforementioned literacies to the communities that they serve. Thus, the Educability open access vocational education and training information literacy package for educato and librarians, as output of Educability, renders transnational effort to cover the aforesaid educational gap.

Objectives

The Project adopts a holistic end-user-driven approach for accomplishing the following objectives:

(A) to develop a freely available Information Literacy Training Package (ILTP) consisting of 6 complete Literacy Models.

(B) to train educators and librarians, in the core skills of Information Literacy, as a horizontal goal, and in new literacies, as a vertical goal.

(C) to converge in terms of strategy, expertise and infrastructure in Information Literacy initiatives, at a transnational level, by the approval of a transnational memorandum of cooperation, sustainability and transferability between the EDUCABILITY Project's partners.

EDUCABILITY is a transnational Project implemented within the Framework of ERASMUS+.
